Times:

Afternoon session is:


Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday from 12:00 – 3:00 pm.



Transportation:

Children may ride the regular school bus to school at 8:00 am or from school at 3:00 pm, if it is within the normal school bus route.

Transportation <u>will not</u> be provided at the mid-day pick-up/drop-off times.



Preschool Requirements:

- The preschool child must be 3 years old by September 1.
- Complete an Early Childhood Preschool Screening at Public Health (631-7629).
- Have up-to-date immunizations.
- Applications need to be completed and returned to Heidi Huotari.
- Parents will receive a letter by the end of August stating what class/group their child is in.
