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School District Plan to Survey Students - 2025 Minnesota Student Survey

Sebeka Public School intends to participate in the 2025 Minnesota Student Survey (MSS). The MSS is conducted in schools across our state every three years. It is administered to students in grades 5, 8, 9, and 11. Federal law requires the school to notify parents of this school activity.

Questions on the survey are about many topics relating to young people's lives. The survey asks about their activities, opinions, behaviors, and experiences. Students respond to questions on school climate, bullying, out of school activities, health and nutrition, emotional and mental health, relationships, substance use, and more. This useful information about their thoughts and behaviors helps communities and schools develop effective programs and provide better services.

The survey is completely anonymous. To prevent individuals or families from being identified, students do not provide their names, student ID numbers, or other personal information. This survey is also voluntary. You may choose to opt your child out of taking the survey. More information regarding the MSS will be provided to students and families in October.

The Minnesota Student Survey will be administered to students in grades 5, 8, 9, and 11 in the spring of 2025.

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
