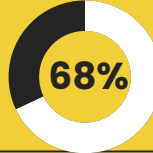

High school grade point average is consistently the strongest predictor of four-year college outcomes for all academic disciplines, campuses and freshman cohorts.



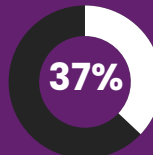

Extracurricular activities are one of the best investments that a school can make to promote achievement and the attitudes and habits that lead to college aspirations and ultimate success.



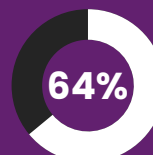
